4. IIBA negotiation update

A new IIBA has been negotiated by the Parties. It will come into effect on 01 April 2016. The spirit and intent of the IIBA remains the same, but some details have changed. For example, the funds to operate the ACMCs will be administered by Nunavut Tunngavik Inc., and appointments to the ACMCs are no longer tied to CBC/CLARC appointment lengths/expiries.

6. Correspondence To and From the ACMC

Jennie sent an email to permit holder BBC One Planet reminding them that they committed to providing a copy of their movie once it is complete. We do not know when it will be completed though.

As discussed at our meeting last May (2015), the ACMC sent letters to the parties of the IIBA (Canadian Wildlife Service, Nunavut Tunngavik Inc and affected Regional Inuit Association (Kitikmeot) about use of the name Ahiak when referring to the Migratory Bird Sanctuary (i.e. Ahiak Migratory Bird Sanctuary), and about initiation the process for converting the Ahiak Migratory Bird Sanctuary to a National Wildlife Area. These letters were sent in June 2015.
