Since our last report, the Ahiak ACMC held the following meetings:

- ## Accomplishments

- Completed appointments to the Ahiak APMC, some of which expired 31 March 2013;
- Approved our Operating Procedures, Conflict of Interest Guidelines, Code of Conduct, and a three-year Work plan and Budget (2011/12-2013/14);
- Held a site visit in the MBS;
- Started production and collected footage and interviews for short and long informational videos on the MBS;
- Created a Draft Management Plan for the MBS; and
- Reviewed four permit applications.

- The Cambridge Bay and Gjoa Haven CLOs continue to be a valuable resource to the Ahiak ACMC and we continue to appreciate their assistance and input to the ACMC.
- The multi-year contract for ACMC logistics for the Ahiak ACMC meetings awarded to Kitnuna Expediting continues to work well.
- We have been fortunate to engage an interpreter who is from the MBS and she has been a value-added asset to our meetings.
- We have had challenges on the side of Environment Canada approvals for meetings that have delayed items in our work plan.

- Hold public and invitational meetings in Cambridge Bay and Gjoa Haven to consult on the draft management plan.
- Finish production of a multi-language Hinterlands Who's Who 'commercial' about the Ahik Queen Maud Gulf Migratory Bird Sanctuary to be distributed to Canadian television stations (1 minute long), and a longer 10+ minute informational video to be distributed throughout the Kitikmeot.
- Re-establish nominations and appointments for 4 of the 6 spots on the committee.
