### 3. Updates

All-ACMC meeting in Iqaluit:  
This event was mentioned briefly during our August teleconference. It was approved by the Minister. It will take place from March 4-6, 2014 (3 days; Tues-Thurs). Travel will be Sunday-Monday and Friday (March 2, 3 and 7, 2014). Armand added to confirmed members able to attend. Darryl will be working at mine during those dates. Randy has not responded.

The intent of the meeting is for ACMCs to be able to share their experiences to date, to all be updated at the same time about some topics. The meeting will all be in Inuktitut (with the exception for some guest presentations like researchers).

Re: Logistics for the meeting. Member professional fees will be paid through our existing contracts. Ahiak ACMC's contractor (Kitnuna) will advance traveler's per diems and pre-pay for their flights and hotels. Rates for meals are set in a federal government policy (National

They have eaten all the grass in the MBSs and are now spreading out all over Southampton Island. These types of concerns are really important to hear, in particular as the ACMC starts management planning for the MBSs. As a committee we'll want to know if the MBSs are serving the purpose for which they were set up for. Do we need to change the boundaries? Should they be NWAs? Should they be de-established? The answers to those questions will form the basis of our recommendations in the management plans.
