1. Nivvialik Area Co-Management Committee (ACMC) Member Appointments
 - The ACMC has six appointed members - three appointed by the KIA and three appointed by Environment Canada.
 - The Environment Canada appointment letters are now completed for Philip Kigusuitnak, Shayne Ubluriak, and Donna Mulders.
 - The KIA letters of appointment have not been completed yet.
 - As per section 3.2.6 of the *Inuit Impact and Benefit Agreement for National Wildlife Areas and Migratory Bird Sanctuaries in the Nunavut Settlement Area*, the appointment of the Chairperson, regardless of which organization appointed that person as a general member, is made by the KIA.
 - The Nivvialik ACMC voted by secret ballot and we recommend David Aglukark Sr. as our Chair. We respectfully request that the KIA support the Nivvialik ACMC's recommendation and make his role as our Chairperson official.

Request: That KIA finalize the appointment of the three KIA appointees and write the letters of appointment for David Aglukark Sr., Peter Alareak, Thomas Ubluriak.
That KIA officially appoints the Nivvialik ACMC Chairperson.
