- In 2010-2011, Kivalliq Inuit Association was contracted to provide logistics support and payment of ACMC expenses. For 2011-2012, due to capacity KIA was not able to take this on. Several Kivalliq companies were approached through a request for proposals but there were no bids from the Kivalliq region. At this time, the ACMC is working on a request for proposals for the 2012-2013 fiscal year.
- For the 2011-2012 logistical support a contract, Arktis, a Gjoa Haven company, was awarded the contract.
- Multi-year contract established with two Arviat translators (Simona Baker and Thomas Suluk) for "as and when needed" translation of ACMC material in the Arviat dialect
- In 2011-2012, as a first stage in the management planning process, a contract was awarded to Aarluk, an Iqaluit consulting firm, to do an inventory of documents and identification of information gaps relevant to the management of the McConnell River Migratory Bird Sanctuary. This involved gathering available ecological and cultural documents and summarizing them.
