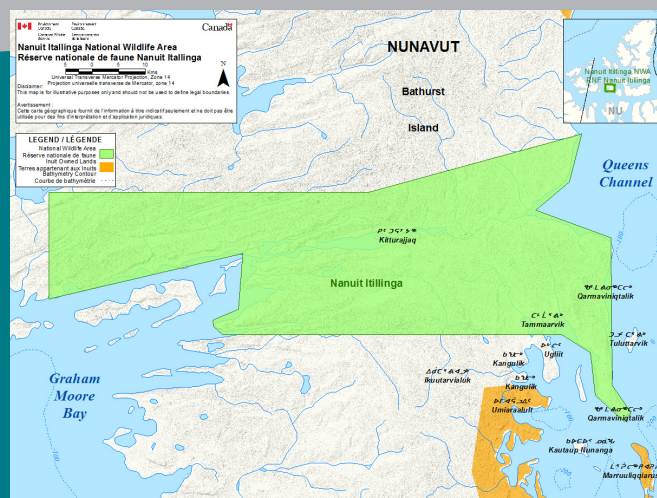
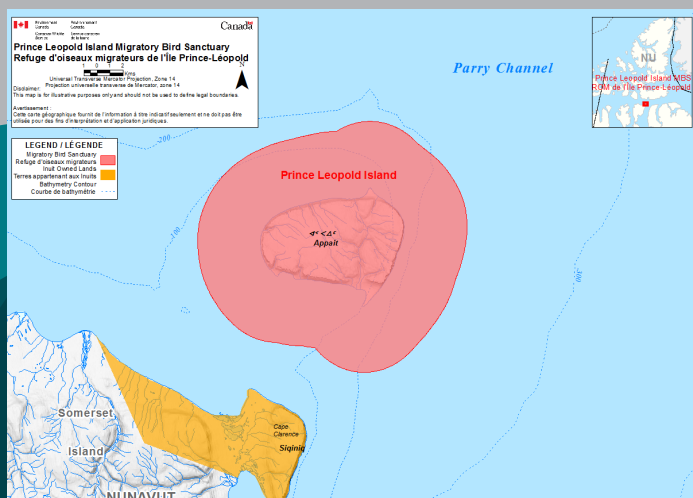
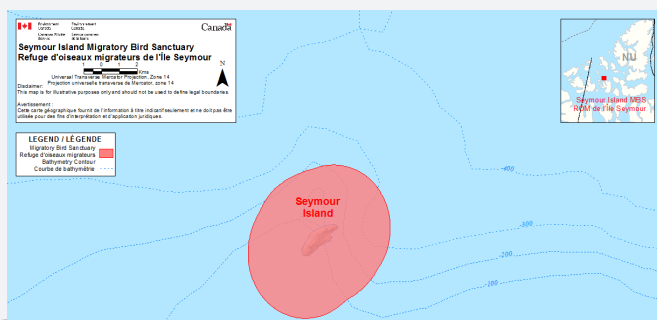

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ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- The ACMC reviewed 14 permit applications for 2019 (seven cruise ships/private yacht request, one land-based tourism request, 2 water testing applications for Remediation and Risk Management Projects with CIRNAC, and four scientific research requests) .
- The ACMC reviewed 11 permit applications for 2020 (nine cruise ships requests, and two scientific research requests)
- The ACMC attended and participated in the all-ACMC meeting in Cambridge Bay, Nunavut in January 2019.
- The ACMC voted to begin the conversion process for Siqiniq (Prince Leopold Island) MBS to become a National Wildlife Area.
- In the process of developing a poster and running a process to find a youth member to join our committee...



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LOGISTICS

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- The ACMC meeting logistic costs were paid directly through NTI.
- Susan Salluviniq provided simultaneous interpretation services at the meeting and translation of meeting materials.
- Meetings were held at ATCO South Camp Inn in Resolute, Nunavut.

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BUDGET

- Expenditures in 2019-2020:\$15,696.50 for ACMC logistics.
- Requesting an operating budget of \$56,500.00 for ACMC logistics for 2020-2021.

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MEETINGS

- The ACMC held 3 meetings in 2019-2020 due to issues with quorum but also a heavy workload. Permit application review, planning for the camera retrieval, National Wildlife Area Strategy, and other ACMC business were discussed. (Two 3-evening meetings, one 2-evening meeting).
- The ACMC also participated in the all-ACMC meeting in Cambridge Bay to discuss management plan workload and best-practices, exchange information, learn from each other and, to the extent possible coordinate ACMC work



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PLANS FOR THE NEAR FUTURE

- Finalize the “Management Considerations” and develop the “Visions, Goals and Objectives” components for the draft management plans.
- Begin engaging the community of Resolute Bay and other local stakeholders.
- Arrange for 3 cameras (trail cams) to be set-up on the plateau of Prince Leopold Island MBS to see if they are a suitable option for tracking ship traffic in the sanctuary.
- Work with Parks Canada Agency and the Qausuittuq JPMC on how to work together to co-manage our adjoining protected areas (Qausuittuq National Park and Nanuit Itillinga National Wildlife Area).
