ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- The ACMC advanced on its work to complete the management plans for both the Akpait and Qaqqullit National Wildlife Areas. The draft plans were submitted for comments to both Nunavut Tunngavik Inc, (NTI), the Qikiqtani Inuit Association (QIA), in addition to Environment and Climate Change Canada (ECCC) subject-matter experts.
- The ACMC reviewed four permit applications for activities in Qaqqullit and Akpait National Wildlife Areas (NWAs) during the 2018 shipping season but only recommended permits be issued to three applicants: two cruise tourism visits (One Ocean Expeditions) and one research permits (Acadia University). A permit was not granted for research to Woods Hole Oceanographic Institution due to the nature and time of the work. The ACMC further received visit reports from all 3 of the permittees, which they reviewed.
- Two ACMC members, Jeannie Toomasie and Stevie Aulaqiaq, participated in the seabird survey (Northern Fulmar, Thick-billed Murre), and contaminate sampling project at Qaqqullit and Akpait NWAs between August 9-16, 2018. This was a collaborative project between Acadia University (permit issued for non-Inuit researchers as stated above) and the community of Qikiqtarjuaq.
- The ECCC Iqaluit office held its annual ACMC training session (January 22-25, 2019), for new members as well as for those whom never received the training. Stevie Aulaqiaq and Jaypootee Aliqatuqtuq were scheduled to attend but only Jaypootee was able to make it.
- As part of the regular operations, the ACMC approved the 2019-2020 work plan and budget.
- Susanne Emond was appointed as the new vice-chair, to replace Karla Abbott, whom is no longer with Environment and Climate Change Canada.

PLANS FOR THE NEAR FUTURE

- Complete the management plans for Qaulluit and Akpait NWAs, for which an open house will be held in the Qikiqtarjuaq community . The intent is for both management plans to be submitted to the Nunavut Wildlife Management Board for approval (December 2019 NWMB meeting) and before they can be approved by the Minister.
- Receiving feedback from the Acadia research team on the results of the seabird survey on contaminants conducted at Akpait and Qaulluit in the summer of 2018.
- Complete the NWA Strategy Questionnaire.
- Having the ECCC Enforcement staff come and present on the regulations, enforcement activities and monitoring.
- Attend the 2nd All-ACMC, which is to be held in Ranking Inlet in February 2020.
- Fill the youth representative position.
- Expand the Qaulluit and Akpait NWAs exhibit at the Gathering House in Qikiqtarjuaq.
